POOL RENTAL Rates & Rules

1. The pool will be available for rent on Friday (after swimming lessons), Saturday and Sunday evenings from 6:00 - 9:00 p.m. and possibly other unscheduled times.
2. The pool may be rented by contacting the Bardstown Parks & Recreation Department office at 502-348-9281, Monday - Friday, 8:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m., closed for lunch 12:30 - 1:30.
3. A representative of the renting group must sign a rental agreement form prior to the night of rental. A non-refundable deposit of 1/2 of the rental fee is required upon signing the rental agreement with the remainder to be paid the workday (before 5:00 p.m.) prior to the pool party. A 48-hour notice is required if the party is cancelled. If notification is not received, full payment is expected.
4. To cancel a pool rental agreement the renter must give 48 hours notice to the Parks & Recreation Department office @ 348-9281, ext. 233, Mon.-Fri., 8:30-12:30/1:30-5:00.
5. In the event of cancellation of the pool rental because of impending bad weather, the Recreation Department office will attempt to reschedule. If rescheduling is not possible, paid fees will be refunded.
6. Food and beverages are allowed in the concession area ONLY. NO GLASS CONTAINERS OR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE ALLOWED.
7. The City of Bardstown will provide all necessary staff and safety equipment to insure the safety of all renting patrons.
8. **Management reserves the right to eject from the pool premises any person failing to comply with pool rules.**

POOL RENTAL RATES

Minimum of 2 hours

50 or less patrons	\$100 per hour
51 - 100 patrons	\$120 per hour
101 - 150 patrons	\$140 per hour
151 - 200 patrons	\$160 per hour

Rental fee increases \$20 per hour/per additional 50 patrons.

POOL RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All patrons must shower before entering the pool.
2. Only swimsuits may be worn in the swimming pool (NO CUT OFFS OR UNDERWEAR). Infants must wear swim diapers. Clean white t-shirts may be worn.
3. No running or horseplay is permitted in pool facilities.
4. Food and/or drink are allowed only in the concession area. No outside food and/or drinks may be brought into the pool facilities. (With the exception of pool parties)
5. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED IN/OR AROUND THE POOL FACILITIES.
6. **Anyone believed to be under the influence of alcohol will be asked to leave all city property including in/or around pool area. Police will be called.**
7. **Smoking is not permitted on the pool premises.**
8. If you exit the pool facility for any reason, you MUST pay to re-enter.
9. No floating devices may be used in pools. Use of balls, frisbees etc. are not allowed in the swimming pool or on the pool deck.
10. Pool management is not responsible for items lost or stolen at the pool. (Lockers are available, must bring own lock.)
11. No refunds will be issued if you are asked to leave for violation of rules.
12. Children 12 years and younger MUST be accompanied by someone 16 years or older at all times with only ONE EXCEPTION, children who are 10 - 12 years old who CAN PASS A DEEP WATER SWIM TEST may stay unaccompanied by adult. Parental consent form must be on file.
13. General Admission must be paid by everyone entering the pool with the following exceptions: 2 & under, 55 & over are free.
14. For the safety of the public no person with infectious/communicable diseases will be admitted to the pool.

MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ADMITTANCE TO OR EJECT FROM THE POOL PREMISES ANY PERSON FAILING TO COMPLY WITH ANY HEALTH, SAFETY REGULATION OR POOL RULES.
