Garbage – Limbs, Brush and Bulky Items

General Guidelines

*Customer **must call City Hall to request pick-up**

*Pile of limbs, brush or bulky items **cannot exceed** four (4) cubic yards -approximately the size of a pickup load

*Bulky items or yard waste will not be picked up from alleyways except those that are wider than ten (10) ft.

Limbs & Brush Piles

Height = 6 feet or less

Width (along street) = 10 feet or less

Limb Size = 6" diameter or less

*Limbs must be neatly stacked with ends facing the street; no root balls or tree trunks

*The City **WILL NOT** pick-up limbs professionally cut

*Piles will be picked up on customer's regular garbage day

*No bundle or container and its contents shall exceed 40 pounds

Please Note: There are times of the year when the volume of limbs and brush are heavier, such as when folks do "spring cleaning". This can create a backlog for the chipper truck. During these times, there may be a delay of service.

The leaf truck runs ONLY in the fall. No leaves will be picked up outside of leaf season. Any small piles of yard waste such as leaves, vines, small clippings, etc., that can be bagged in yard waste bags or tied in small bundles no larger than 48" long and 18" in diameter, may be set out with the weekly garbage and picked up by the garbage crews.

Bulky Items

Any garbage that contains hazardous materials or items that pose a safety or health risk to City Garbage Workers will not be picked up.

****Any mattress, couch, etc. infested with bed bugs will NOT be picked up by the City Garbage Dept. as this poses a health risk to City Garbage Workers.***

Prohibited Garbage Items:

Liquid Waste – poisons, acids, explosives

Paints

Petroleum Products (oil, grease, gasoline, etc.)

Tires or Car Parts

Loose items not bundled or in a container

Hazardous Waste – syringes, used needles

Construction Waste – drywall, used lumber, rolls of carpet or padding, remodeling debris
