

POLICE CHIEF CITY OF BARDSTOWN, KENTUCKY

The City of Bardstown, Kentucky, population 12,000, located in Nelson County, Kentucky, seeks qualified applicants for the position of Police Chief. Bardstown is the county seat of Nelson County, Kentucky home of My Old Kentucky Home, and was voted “Most Beautiful Small Town in America by Rand McNally in 2012. Bardstown is located approximately 40 minutes from downtown Louisville.

Bardstown operates under a City Council form of government, with the Police Chief reporting directly to the Mayor, as a department head. The Police Department has an annual budget of approximately \$2.9 million with 27 full-time officers, along with a full time office administrator and a part time evidence room technician.

Applicants must have a high level of honesty and integrity. College degree preferred, supplemented by 5 years of progressively responsible professional law enforcement and supervisory experience. Knowledge of the budget management process and interpersonal skills are required. Successful completion of Certified Peace Officer training administered or approved by the Kentucky Department of Criminal Justice Training is required.

The Chief serves at a salary, based upon qualifications. Benefits include Health Insurance and Retirement System contributions. Must possess valid driver’s license, be able to pass extensive background check and drug test.
